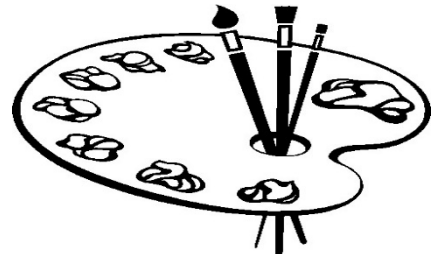
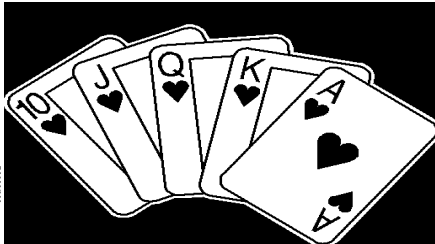
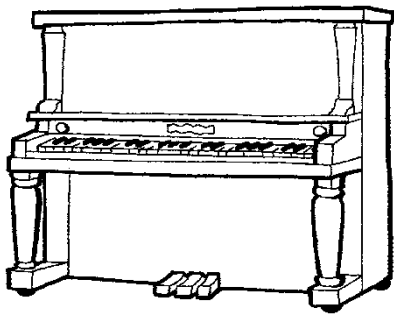


N.C. ASSISTED LIVING ACTIVITY PROFESSIONAL TRAINING CLASS

Sponsored by The Coalition of Resident Councils (The CORC) and is approved by the Division of Health Services Regulation (DHSR), Adult Care Licensure Section.

This course meets the administrative code 10A NCAC 13F .0404 (2)

“Qualifications of Activity Director” for Adult Care Homes in NC.



The course will meet on **THURSDAYS** over the course of 5 months. Class time is 1pm to 4:15pm. Week #1, the class will meet for one (1) hour only from 1:00pm to 2:00pm for class orientation. A ZOOM meeting format will be utilized. Minimal travel required locally. You can take the class right on your computer. You need to have a camera and microphone on your computer in order to participate. These classes are “live” sessions, so you do need to be in class during the class time.

Course dates are: **SEPTEMBER 23, 2021** from 1:00pm to 2:00pm for Orientation and the Course requirements. Orientation is **mandatory**. Class will meet for 3.0 hours on **THURSDAYS** beginning October 7, 2021 and will end on March 3, 2022. Classes will **not** be held on: September 30, November 11 and 25, December 23 and 30, 2021.

Course content is 85+ Hours consisting of the following:

- 52 hours virtual class time
- 33 + hours practicum/clinical/homework/class project
- Final exam

Kathy Wright Moore, LRT/CTRS, ACC/EDU primary Instructor, has 40 years of experience working with older adults in a wide variety of settings. Guest lecturers include “seasoned” professionals, many certified by the National Certification Council for Activity Professionals (NCCAP).
