

Respiratory Protection Administrator and Fit Testing – Train-the-Trainer

Virtual Training hosted by NC Public Health Preparedness and Response (PHP&R)

Training Description

The purpose of this training is to provide long term care facilities in North Carolina information to administer an Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) compliant Respiratory Protection Program. Attendees will be provided guidance on creating an OSHA complaint Respiratory Protection Program to include a written plan, proper procedures for respirator fit testing, recordkeeping, and other necessary program elements. Upon completion, attendees will be able to train others to be fit testers using the qualitative (hood) method.



Why Attend this Training?

OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134 requires any employer where staff utilize respirators (N95s) as a function of employment to implement a Respiratory Protection Program.

Who Can Attend this Training?

The target audience is individuals who will serve as Respiratory Protection Program Administrators at long term care facilities in North Carolina.
